



Moving Home – A Checklist

Living Room/Lounge

- Remove all mirrors, pictures and hooks.
- Remove curtain rails, tiebacks and hooks.
- Remove any Hi-fi speakers or brackets.
- Remove any light fittings you intend taking with you.
- If you have a gas fire arrange for it to be disconnected.

Kitchen

- Remove any wall racks.
- Empty all bins and ensure you have a kettle handy.
- Washing machine and dishwasher should be disconnected.
- Cooker should also be disconnected.
- Defrost Fridge/Freezer.
- Check all drawers in units and cupboards.

Bedrooms

- Remove any mirrors, pictures and hooks.
- Remove curtain rails, tiebacks and hooks.
- Ensure that all cupboards, fitted wardrobes and shelves are cleared.
- Remove any additional light fittings.

Bathroom

- Remove scales, mats, towels, shower rail, curtain rails and toiletries.
- Ensure bathroom cabinets and cupboards are emptied.
- The shower may need disconnecting.

Attic/Garage

- Ensure the attic is emptied.
- Ensure workbenches, shelves and tools are removed from the garage.

Garden

- If you are taking the garden shed with you make arrangements for it to be dismantled.
- Check that all garden fittings are removed.

The Final Check

- Check behind all doors.
- Check Living Room/ Lounge are empty.
- Check Kitchen is empty.
- Check all cupboards are empty.
- Check Garage and Attic are empty.
- Take Gas Reading.
- Take Electricity Reading.
- Take Water Reading if applicable.
